PARENTS RIGHT TO KNOW

The Brookfield R-III School District is required to inform parents/guardians of each student who attends a school receiving Title I.A funds of the following information annually:

Upon your request, the Brookfield R-III School District is required to provide to you in a timely manner, information regarding the professional qualifications of your child's classroom teachers which will include, at a minimum, the following:

- whether the teacher has met state qualification and licensing criteria for the grade levels and subject areas in which the teacher provides instruction;
- whether the teacher is teaching under emergency or other provisional status through which state qualification or licensing criteria have been waived;
- whether the teacher is teaching in the field of discipline of the certification of the teacher; and,
- whether your child is provided services by paraprofessionals, and, if so, their qualifications.

In addition to the above information that parents may request, a school that receives Title I.A funds must provide to each individual parent:

- information on the level of achievement and academic growth of their student, if applicable and available, on each of the state academic assessments required under Title I.A; and,
- timely notice their child has been assigned, or has been taught, for four or more consecutive weeks by a teacher who has not met applicable state certification or licensure requirements at the grade level and subject area in which the teacher has been assigned.
